### Overview:

These trainings are designed for Maine Immunization Program (MIP) Providers. For the convenience of providers, the sessions will be held in four different locations. The four sessions will have the same content and providers are encouraged to participate in one of the sessions. The training will include updates in vaccine storage and handling, review of requirements and reporting for providers who receive public vaccine, and use of the immunization registry, ImmPact2 (including user required confidentiality and security training for using the system).

### Purpose:

- (1) To provide ongoing updates as part of a comprehensive approach to meet the federal CDC's funding requirements and to improve immunization in the State of Maine
- (2) Provide an opportunity to access Maine Immunization Program personnel and other appropriate resources.

### Intended Audience:

Health professionals (office managers or administrators; nurses [Including school nurses] physicians and physician assistants) from provider offices that are responsible for managing public funded vaccines or work with child and/or adult immunizations.
